## Personal record

**'Reflect, discuss, ask, record.'**

An accurate assessment of your skills and experience for voluntary work could also help prove to an employer that you've carefully thought about what they're looking for.

### Skills you've gained from

<b>Work</b> Current and past jobs	e.g. book-keeping, IT, promotions, staff training
<b>Interests</b> What you enjoy doing	e.g. gardening, DIY, sports, music, crafts, car maintenance, good with animals
<b>Life experience</b>	e.g. self-starter, entrepreneur, combining career with running a home

## Personal qualities

<b>Self-assessment</b> How would you describe yourself? Be realistic	e.g. flexible, hard working
<b>Family and friends</b> What would your family say? Be brave, ask them. Even negative comments are useful here	e.g. 'doesn't suffer fools gladly', generous, good organiser
<b>Colleagues</b>	e.g. conscientious, pays attention to detail, enthusiastic
