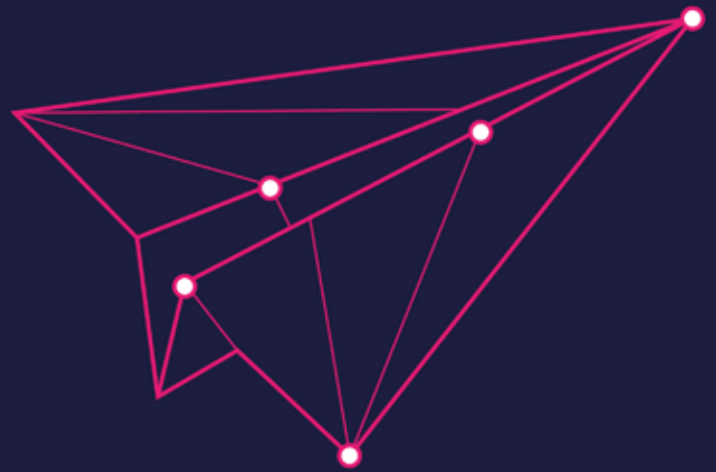


Learning at Work Week
