Betty Luckham:

Well, it's a question of what encouragement and support can we give to those who want to contribute. And sometimes it's not always obvious. You have to talk to people. And the fact that there are people-- some people from the black community who are confident, who have achieved and are prepared to stand up and give an opinion, it means that example is very, very important, especially for the young people coming out of school into the large world which has difficulties that have to be overcome.

I think the world is-- I wouldn't say a different place to when I was a younger woman, but there are a number of different factors at play. And the way that-- the challenges, for example, that young people face, I think those challenges can sometimes lead them into dangerous situations. And they do need to have the wisdom and the encouragement of the older generation, which helps to keep them going.
