**SPEAKER 1:** The ritual ceremony of the voladores, it's a ceremony-- it's a ceremonial dance that is started 1,500 years ago and it has been passed from generation to generation to generation till our days.

But it's a great feeling to share this and to see all the people get moving. And it gets moving not for watching the thing on TV or watching a live ceremony and being part of it.

It's a communal ceremony. I mean, you cannot fly one person. There's four people flying there and if there were three they couldn't fly. It's a ceremony that changes the people, not only the performing, because the people that sees it and that lives it, we as public, we all also live it, you know.
