The course introduces critical influencing and lobbying skills. It helps you to develop agency and skills to campaign and organise for change in organisations and communities.

You will learn the difference between equality and equity. The course covers equality legislation and explores how Black and racialised minority leaders can leverage the public sector duty to influence change.

The course explores constructive decent and destructive consent in the context of Black and racialised minority leadership.

You will learn about the legacy of colonialism, neo-colonialism, and slavery on Black leadership in the UK.
