So here, I used the data to show the age distribution of United Kingdom. Age on this axis and number of people here. I divided the number of people into 15-year age group-- 15, 30, 45, 60 years old.

It's a simplified population pyramid with men and women together. And look in the United Kingdom, it's more or less the same number of people in all age group, except in the oldest. You can use the data to make your own chart.
