## 5.10 Ranking activity

## Answer:

The correct chronological order is:

- 1. The safeguarding concern is reported to the Safeguarding Officer/Focal Point.
- 2. Gather more information, if necessary.
- 3. Convene a Safeguarding committee.
- 4. If the concern is serious and is a breach of the Code of Conduct, start an internal investigation.
- 5. If an investigation takes place, consider suspending the Subject of Concern and/or the programme, if necessary.
- 6. If an investigation takes place, receive a report with the findings.
- 7. Undertake disciplinary action, if appropriate, in line with organisational HR processes.
- 8. Ensure that learning from the case is incorporated back into the organisation.
