Girls	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Gender</li> <li>● Age Ethnic minority</li> <li>● Illiterate or unschooled</li> <li>● Survivors of domestic violence</li> </ul>	<p>The intersectionality of these criteria and factors means that girls are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● At risk of physical, emotional and sexual abuse, or neglected due to age, gender, race and/or lack of opportunities (H)</li> <li>● At risk of being illiterate due to loss of education (H)</li> <li>● At risk of being trafficked (H)</li> <li>● At risk of early and forced marriage (H)</li> <li>● At risk of continued discrimination because of race (M)</li> <li>● At risk of being abused or neglected at home (H)</li> </ul>
