SPEAKER: There's a lot of teacher collaboration because teachers usually consult one another when planning their lessons. And usually, in CPDs, that's where you find them asking questions as to how one would teach that lesson, the different approaches that one can involve in the lesson, and even how to introduce, go about the development and the conclusion. So, they are working together for them to deliver perfect lessons for the learners.

The other improvement that I've seen is the learner-to-learner interaction. Learners are now able to interact because of the teaching approaches, such as peer work, group work, event storytelling. As we observed in the adolescent, a child was able to tell a story without even feeling shy. So, at least learners are now free to speak out. They're able to interact with one another, which is what we wanted.
